RE: Compliance Timelines: Areas Impacted by Hurricane Matthew

Many of our local education agencies (LEAs) in Districts 1-4 have experienced a significant impact on educational programs as a result of Hurricane Matthew. The EC Division recognizes that the primary focus in many of these LEAs is to locate displaced families and transition back to the instructional calendar. Concurrently, LEAs have reporting requirements specific to class size/caseload waivers, overall compliance with Indicators 11 and 12, and other corrective action timelines that may have been issued as a result of a state complaint or monitoring visit.

During this time, please coordinate with your assigned monitoring consultant and/or dispute resolution consultant to problem-solve each unique circumstance with reporting requirements or corrective action timelines.
