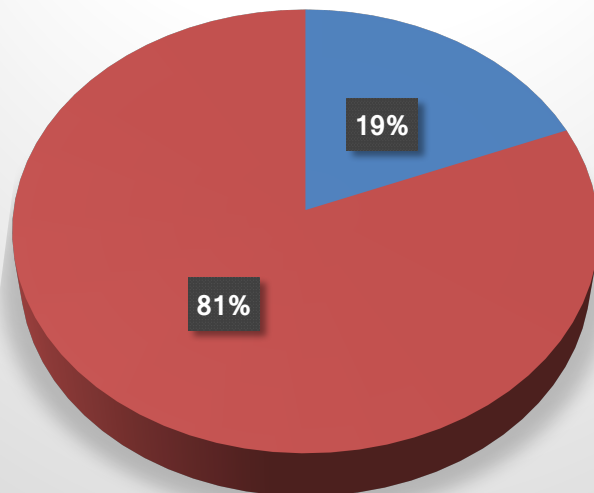
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Special Education State Complaints End of Year Report July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016
