IDEA PART B 611 AND 619 GRANT APPLICATION DUE DATE EXTENSION

The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) has completed its annual State Application for receiving grant award under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) as amended in 2004; however, North Carolina has not yet received the planning allotment information for the State IDEA grant. Without the IDEA federal planning allotment, NCDPI's Allotment Section is unable to begin to calculate the IDEA Part B 611 and 619 grant planning allotments for LEAs, Charters and State Operated Programs.

Because of the delay in receiving the IDEA federal planning allotment, both the IDEA Part B 611 and 619 grant application due dates have been extended to **Friday**, **June 23**, **2017**. It is anticipated that grant planning allotments will be available in early June 2017 and that data will be made available in the IDEA Part B grant application under Planning Allotments.
