

Meeting Student Unique Mealtime Participation Needs within a Multi-Tier System of Supports (MTSS):

Leadership Module

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Meeting a student's unique mealtime needs (UMN; e.g., meal modifications and/or services required due to allergies, diabetes, other health problems, swallowing issues, and/or social-emotional-behavioral issues) is a complex process often requiring specialized inter-professional evaluation, intervention, and progress monitoring. Students who require support for mealtime participation have needs that vary in type, resources required, intensity, and duration. Using MTSS as an organizing framework, this full-day course will equip LEA and charter school leaders in establishing and sustaining individualized mealtime programming while adhering to multiple requirements under USDA, IDEA, Section 504, state law, and local policies. The session will investigate best practices, relevant statute and policies, and existing state and local resources for supporting students with unique mealtime participation needs and provide teams with planning time.

Recommended Team Participants from each LEA/Charter School:

Team registration should include at least 3 of the roles listed below:

- School Nutrition Director or designee
- Exceptional Children Director or designee (e.g., Lead Related Services Coordinator)
- Student Services Director or designee (e.g., Central Office Section 504 Coordinator)
- Lead Nurse or RN Nurse Supervisor
- Lead Speech-Language Pathologist and/or Lead Occupational Therapist
