SUBJECT: New Directors' Leadership Institute (NDLI) 2018-20 Cohort

DATE: April 4, 2018

The New Directors' Leadership Institute provides opportunities to develop knowledge and skills in each of six areas of competencies over a two-year (up to 135 hours) training cycle. The training cycle includes three two- and one half-day and five two-day Institute Sessions (see attached). The training consists of research-based competencies which were developed and grouped into training modules.

The Exceptional Children Division has made a commitment to provide training by individuals, both state and local, who are knowledgeable of the Exceptional Children Program Directors' (ECPD) position. Content is developed based on the competency areas identified as essential to the role of EC Directors. Participants are expected to attend all sessions, and complete on-site and off-site assignments. ECPD with less than two years of service are invited to apply for the NDLI. Participants who are currently serving as EC Directors will be accepted into the training first. Additional space availability will be open to district level leadership positions to support capacity building for future EC Directors, and the Division respectfully requests a limit of two participants per district, unless space permits otherwise. A district with an ECPD vacancy, that is anticipating hiring prior to September 2018, may complete an application for the position. There is a \$425 registration fee for each year of participation. Please complete the enclosed application and submit the registration fee for year one to the address on the application by July 15, 2018.

Requirements for Exceptional Children Program Director licensure include: hold a master's degree in special education or a related field, complete an additional nine hours of graduate course credit, obtain a passing score on the Educational Leadership (0410) PRAXIS examination and obtain a recommendation by a local education agency.

The New Directors' Leadership Institute will provide CEUs upon completion of all sessions and the program requirements. We are currently able to offer the opportunity to acquire the additional nine hours of graduate credit through East Carolina University Graduate School. Additional information will be provided to registered participants when their registration is finalized. Current Exceptional Children Directors who do not hold an ECPD license should contact their Human Resources Director regarding steps necessary to secure licensure for this supervisory role.

Applicants will receive a letter indicating acceptance into the Institute. If accepted, the letter will include additional information about the initial session. Applicants who are not accepted will receive a full refund of the registration fee. If you have questions about the application process, please contact the Regional Coordinator for your region.
